**61/2012 PUBLIC PARTICIPATION**

**61.2012.1 PUBLIC SPEAKING**

A lady spoke about the license application for 59 The Knoll, and why when the Parish Council had objected against this, this had not been received at Derbyshire Dales District Council.

The clerk spoke about the letter being sent on 30 July 2011, she apologised for the fact that it had not been received; it was not emailed and not recorded post. The application would be heard by the licensing committee on 5 September and the clerk would attend if anyone wished her to do so.

The chair informed the meeting that she had been approached by someone in favour of the application. One gentleman said that his application was classified as not relevant.

An order has been given to William Smart to carry out weed spraying around the Fete Field area, and also to trim some of the weeds etc. This would cost in the region of £30.

**69/2012 ENVIRONMENTAL ISSUES**

**69.2012.1 Burial Ground;Regulations/Burial of Ashes –**

The chair highlighted the problem with Burial of Ashes, there is no area set aside in the new Burial Ground and suggests that the last three rows of grave spaces be given over to a Garden of Remembrance, this could possibly be planted with roses.

The Church has also been consulted over the proposed regulations for the Burial Ground.

**RESOLVED:**

To write to DDDC and seek their opinion on this, to seek quotations from G Pearson, B Wood, D Ball and Arlington for making the wall onto Gold Hill higher, to consult with the Church.

**69.2012.2 Footpath Maintenance –** Work continues, Footpaths 6 and 2 are on the schedule. Footpath on the Knoll near Hunters Moon needs

the alder self sets removing. The footpath edging is also eroding very badly, the edging has rotted. Cllr Taylor reported that DCC are going to investigate and deal with the footpath that is blocked.

**RESOLVED:**

To write to DCC about the edging boards.

**69.2012.3 Dog Waste Bin –** Alders Lane, the bin would soon be in place, there has been some confusion with the bins at Derbyshire Dales.

**69.2012.4 Riber View Close** – A number of utility plans have now been received, these would be passed to the residents, the Parish Council have also been asked for funding for a planter.

**RESOLVED:**

To sign off the Licence to Cultivate and to fund a planter when residents have decided upon the design.

**69.2012.5 Footpath 7/8** removal of metal post and installation of wooden finger post.

The clerk informed the meeting that a holding response had been received from DCC.

**69.2012.6 Nottingham Road – overhanging trees and vegetation opposite junction Church Street**

There is increasing pressure for a crossing on the A615, particularly if the children have to cross to access transport. As more houses are allowed the safety of the residents and children should be paramount and there should be something in place to slow the traffic down.
