11/2013 ENVIRONMENTAL ISSUES

11.2013.1 Footpaths 12 & 2 – ongoing but need to write again about footpath 2.

11.2013.2 The Cliff – to write again about this to the landowner

11.2013.3 Village Entrance

There are concerns still about this, there seems to be two entrances, and more hardcore has gone down in that area, there seems to be a newer splay but it is very untidy.

11.2013.4 Riber View Close – donation of tree by resident

Mr & Mrs Dornan wish to donate a tree for the end of Riber View Close, we need to gain residents' views and approach utilities.

11.2013.5 Village Litter Pick – DDDC will provide litter pickers, all the kit needed for this and will collect the litter afterwards, need to think about dates and areas. Need to notify the police of these dates, areas.

11.2013.6 Village Green – additional planting

The stepped area needs planting, with some evergreens, lavenders etc. Cllr Taylor would organise this.

11.2013.7 Possible Cultivation Sites – to be discussed at a later date.

11.2013.8 Bench – an email has been received regarding a commemorative bench down at The Dams, it might be an idea to move an existing bench and then replace this.

The Chair sought the Meeting's permission to return to Police Matters to allow PC Neville to speak

PC Neville introduced herself, and her wish to become involved in the village, she covers Darley Dale, Tansley, Matlock and Matlock Bath. She has been checking speeds on A615 near The Royal Oak. She has spent time at The School with the cycling proficiency. She has been working in the village generally on neighbourhood watch, with Tansley youngsters. She wants to know about the litter picks and any community initiative.

Thanks were given to PC Neville and she left the meeting.

12/2013 TRAFFIC ISSUES

12.2013.1 A615 Update

A response has been received from Cllr Allsopp, there are to be new road markings and bumper strips, she has also referred our letter on to an Officer of DCC for a more technical response.

12.2013.2 Nottingham Road/Church Street-trees blocking sight lines

Still ongoing.

12.2013.3 Street Nameplates - The Knoll, Church Street/Nottingham Road junction, Alders Lane/A615 junction. Carr Lane street nameplate at the top of Alders Lane is also missing.

The nameplates are still missing.

12.2013.4 Church Street Parking - there are problems with parking at the junction of Church Street and Nottingham Road, a discussion took place on how this could be overcome, 20mph? in the village.

12.2013.5 Additional VAS – cost

13/2013 THE COMMUNITY HALL

There are moves for a community shop and coffee facilities to possibly start operating one day per week from the community hall, which would increase the usage, which would be very beneficial to the village.

13.2013.1 Surveyors Report

Cllr Raynes and Cllr Flitter have met with DDDC to see if they would 'gift' the hall to the Parish Council. A survey was carried out about three years ago. A copy of this would be requested.

Any amendments to the lease need to go to Committee at DDDC.

14/2013 RECREATION

14.2013.1 Fete Field – Basket Ball/Netball

To expand the facilities on the Fete Field, we need to look at the area to the rear of the houses, see if this is suitable

14.2013.2 Street Games

DDDC are putting on free sessions, 4 weeks @1.5 hours in August, and the Parish Council could expand on this and include children 8+, which would help the community during the holidays.

RESOLVED:

To get a quote for further time, and set aside £240 for this.

15/2013 VILLAGE MEETING

Feedback was given on the village meeting, which was quite positive and well attended, there are concerns about the buses which run from Tansley and do not connect with the train service to Derby, if it was five minutes earlier it would.

16/2013 VILLAGE PLAN

All of the information needs to be pulled together and then it will be published.

The Tansley Development Association are taking this forward.

18/2013 BURIAL GROUND – LANDSCAPING

Cllr Taylor would take some photographs of the suitable memorials for the internment of ashes and bring to a further meeting. There should be better signage, 'dogs to be kept on leads', 'no public right of way', 'we welcome users of the path, please respect this sacred ground', 'this gate may be locked at certain times' – temporary sign.

With regards to the path, to ensure that it does not become a 'right of way' an advert should be placed with regards the closure on one day per year.
