The Chairman sought to vary the order of business to accommodate the urgent matters of the Burial Ground Gate & Thatchers Croft water problem.

151.2014.1 PUBLIC SPEAKING

Car parking on the footways was raised, this is not acceptable, and a note would be put on cars to advise against this. There are also cars parking right on the junctions. The Police would also look into this.

Cllr Flitter had recently seen a near accident at on the corner near The Gate.

A resident of Thatchers Croft has been in contact with the Parish Council regarding the rising damp and the expensive heating system. There are also problems with standing water on the road, the 'badger run' at the bank is eroding with the volume of water, the grass is not growing because of the water.

The Chairman has been to see these issues, Cllr Flitter has also attended.

The Parish Council would write to the Peak District Rural Housing Association to put these matters forward, copies to Cllr Andy Botham, Cllr J Stevens, DDDC Env Health & Planning, J Neville.

A resident asked if the 'SUDS' have ever been installed.

Cllr Botham gave the offer to the Council to meet with representatives to discuss the West Yard situation, and to look at the correspondence.

Concern was expressed about the condition of the Alders Field development, the road is not properly surfaced yet, and the weather and turning vehicles is making the stone wash onto Alders Lane which is dangeroud. The Parish Council would write to the developer regarding this.

155/2014 REPORT BACK FROM SITE MEETING WITH DERBYSHIRE COUNTY COUNCILLOR ANDY BOTHAM

The Chairman and Councillor Strange had met with Cllr Botham and two Officers' to see the problems with road safety and speeding motorists.

Cllr Botham has spoken with CREST to have the area assessed for suitability of speed reduction measures.

With regards to the shared VAS, Cllr Botham is looking at a way forward on this. The site is unsuitable for a 'lollipop patrol', there are no footways, and it is unsafe to put a crossing so traffic calming measures may be installed, to slow down vehicles.

The self set trees on Nottingham Road would be dealt with, as would the overhanging tree on the footway.

Cllr Botham would try to attend on bi-monthly basis to discuss matters and take questions.

Cllr Botham was thanked for attending the meeting.
