15/00800/FUL Erection of dwelling (modification to permission 15/00022/FUL to allow for erection of detached garage) at Land Adjacent to Ivy House Nottingham Road Tansley – no objections (2 abstentions)

15/00807/CPLUD Certificate of Lawful Proposed Development – erection of ancillary building at 1 Oak Tree Gardens, Tansley – object, it is out of keeping with the area, would have no objection to extending the garage which would be keeping with the houses.

15/00822/FUL Conversion and alteration of building to provide manager accommodation at Royal Oak Inn, Alfreton Road, The Cliff, Tansley – object strongly, dangerous access and egress there is poor visibility and there are no splays, problem of domestic drainage going into public house drains, some of the garden of the pub could be made into parking and a permanent access to the barn created through the car park, request that the spaces are increased by 4, the old access onto the A615 should be closed off to allow a courtyard garden. Suggest that highways have a site visit.

15/00835/FUL Alterations and extensions to create two storey dwelling with rear balcony at 44 The Knoll Tansley – no objections, but it needs to be in stone to be in keeping with the area as it is adjacent to the conservation area, the wooden finish detracts from the area, inadequate vehicle spaces, no visitors parking and no turning space – this should be rectified, this is on a road without any footways.

15/00863/OUT Demolition of workshop and erection of dwelling (outline) at Mor Farm, Foxholes Lane, Tansley – object, out of settlement, encouraging sprawl and setting a precedent, is part of the holding on common land, if so can it form part of the holding. Will they be replacing the building?
