36/2016 PUBLIC PARTICIPATION PUBLIC SPEAKING

a) A question was raised about the play area and the possibility of getting a grant of up to £10K from Big Lottery. Funding could be possible but the parish council would have to take over the lease to enable the parish council to apply for a grant. There could be insurance implications from this. Another option could be a Section 106 Agreement arising from Housing Developments in the village, there might be a possibility of putting this forward to the Tansley House Gardens developer.

There is still water coming up from below the swings on the play area, the parish council would once again write about this. The Parish Council would also look at the possibility of finding grants. The Parish Council would need the views of DDDC in writing prior to any further progress.

- b) The matter of a village carnival was also discussed. In the past there has been the summer fayre organised by the Tansley Development Association, but in the last couple of years this has not been held. The Parish Council would support and encourage anyone who wished to organise a carnival or fete or similar.
- c) The condition of the bottom of West Yard was also discussed, the vegetation is overhanging the main road, the developer stated that he would get this trimmed next week.

41.2015.1 Applications for consideration:

15/00453/FUL Extensions and alterations to public house and external works(modification to 14/00693/FUL) The Gate Inn Tansley.

The application was discussed and there was concern over the Section 207 agreement for closing off the access and opening of the other access. Comments were made about the number of car parking spaces, there are not enough for the expected use, the overspill car parking spaces are not defined. The Parish Council have no objections if the spaces are increased from 33 to 43, and the extra 10 spaces are completed in a porous surface, the conditions that were missed by DDDC on the last application should be included at this point.

The parish council welcome the upgrade of the pub and the increase to trade.
