1. A year ago planning permission was granted to ALS Scaffolding for a building to store scaffolding as granted, however, about three months ago, alterations were made to the building, windows and a satellite dish were installed. The building now appears to be a warehouse and distribution premises for bicycle parts, couriers are up and down the lane all day. There is also planning consent for a stable and further building. The gentleman who has complained had met with DDDC planner who seemt to have an attitude of indifference. The Parish Council would write to DDDC & DCC about this matter and the contravention of planning conditions.

2. There is a bungalow at Three Lanes Ends which is part in DDDC & part in NEDDC, and it appears to be a holiday centre and advertises on the internet. This would be queried at DDDC.

3. There was some concern about the proposed Severn Trent works and the diversion signs, that are ambiguous, local people know that the road is open but visitors do not. The Parish Council would write to STWA and DCC about this.
