

# PRIDE IN TANSLEY

Notes from meeting held at Yew Tree Cottage on 11<sup>th</sup> April 2011

**Those present:** Chris Knightley, Polly Morten, Teanie Dornan, John Rigarlsford and Emma Hrubiak.

## 1. Review of points/actions from last meeting

**a. Brookfields Industrial estate:** Re EMIB judges' report section A bullet 1, Brian to speak to Ian Strange about promoting interest among the owners/tenants of the industrial estates/areas. He will also ask for an item to be put on the agenda for March's parish council meeting.

**Chris, in both Ken Gray's and Brian's absence, agreed to ask TPC to include this in their April meeting.**

**b. More planting:** Re EMIB judges' report section A bullet 2,

i) John Rigarlsford will invite Nicki from Matlock Garden Centre to the next meeting.

ii) Polly and Brian will survey the village for areas needing to be improved e.g. with bulbs, shrubs or trees etc. and litter clearance, tidying up etc. on 3<sup>rd</sup> March. Perhaps the garden centre could help with supplies etc.

**Polly carried further surveys. The Old Coach Road verges are a mess. The industrial area is very untidy.**

**We agreed that planters could be placed at Mais Close, Riber View Close and on Church Street in front of Oak Tree Gardens.**

**c. Interpretation boards:** Re EMIB judges' report section B bullet 1 above, **Chris will follow up with Vicki Raynes, TPC chairman.**

**d. Evidence of winter planting and work:** **Chris has produced several drafts of the 2011 portfolio and distributed them by email to the group.**

**e. Horticultural show:** **On hold for this year. Chris will ask for a Hotwire to be issued saying that the event will not happen this year.**

**f. Open Gardens:** **We propose that all money raised initially is used by PIT to fund improvements in the village, e.g. planters etc. We propose gardens be open between 11am and 4pm on Sunday 28/6. Tickets would be £3. We need to provide all information on the ticket on a double-side of A5 to keep costs down (approx. 5p/copy). Chris will ask Brian to speak directly to potential garden openers to try to enlist them.**

**g. Printed Trail Guide:** **Teanie has bought the leaflet holder. Mary Eatherden is updating the leaflets.**

## 2. Other points raised:

John will ask the school for a stall/place at the school fair on 18/6. We will display some information about PIT on boards that Emma will borrow for us. Teanie kindly agreed to donate £20 to printing costs. Emma will find out printing costs from her place of work.
