Notes from meeting held at Yew Tree Cottage on 8th March 2010

Those present: Chris Knightley, Anita Longworth, Polly Morten, Rita Sayers, Dorothy Toplis, Teanie Dornan, Ken Gray and Brian Taylor (presiding)

New items raised and discussed

For the group to receive funding it is necessary to have a Bank Account. CK has been to RBS to collect application forms. RBS offer a good current/deposit account linkage option, as used by the Village Hall. TD proposed that an RBS Bank Account be opened. PM seconded. The motion was carried. Signatories to the account will be Brian Taylor, Polly Morten and Ken Gray. At any given time it will be necessary to have 2 of the 3 signatories to sign cheques.

CK presented a completed off the peg constitution suitable for charities as produced by The Charity Commission. Necessary if PIT is to bid for and receive funding. TD proposed that that the constitution be adopted. PM seconded. Carried unanimously.

CK outlined the suggested layout for the 2010 portfolio; he intends to adopt the EMIB model; the sections comprising the '3 pillars' – Community Participation, Horticulture Achievement and Environmental Responsibility. The portfolio would be primarily pictorial and a working document to be built on reviewed and revisited up to EMIB submission in July. Suggested extra items for inclusion:

- Recycling at the Tavern
- The monthly Skip at the Gate (landlord Tom Connor, has kindly advertised the collection dates on Tansley Hotwire)
- Planters in the village before and after
- Anything else anyone may think suitable for inclusion – please contact CK.

Ken Gray has kindly agreed to join the group and to play an active part.

Mais Close issues. KG will write to Gerald Taylor at Acclaim Housing re work at Mais Close following on from TD's letter to Dales Housing and their subsequent response. TD to provide KG with details.

Maintenance of tubs on village green. BT to take up with Parish Council.

KG explained how business sponsorship helped to subsidise the provision and maintenance of tubs and baskets in the village.

Footpath maintenance. KG and BT to follow up honorarium for foot path maintenance and schedule of work done etc. It was felt that there was a need for accountability and formalisation of the role.

Footways. BT & KG to request Parish Council to clear footpaths of overhanging ivy brambles on walls on the corner of Church St with the Knoll and on Nottingham Road from The Tavern to the Garden Centre.

Anita Longworth raised the issue of increased dog fouling. BT said photographic evidence was needed and could be dealt with through DDDC.
