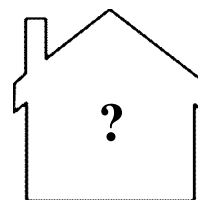

On Wednesday 7th July the Parish Council will hold a Public Meeting on future housing developments in Tansley. The meeting, in the Village Hall, will start at 7.30pm. You are welcome to come along and put your views, or just listen.

Derbyshire Dales District Council has identified Tansley as a location which can accommodate 30 new homes; suggested sites are labelled as "greenfield", outside the current settlement boundary. It is the only village in the area earmarked for development of this type.
