POLICE SURGERIES IN TANSLEY STARTING SUNDAY 6TH JUNE

Police Surgeries are being extended across the neighbourhood to include Tansley. The first surgeries here will be held at 11am-noon on Sunday 6th June and Sunday 25th July at the mobile police station which parks near the bottom of the Village Green (opposite Mais Close). No appointment is necessary.

VILLAGE HALL WINS £5,000 GRANT FROM DERBYSHIRE FUNDER

Tansley Village Hall has received an award of £5,000 (the maximum possible) from Derbyshire Community Foundation for the rebuilding and enlargement of the toilet extension and the new front entrance. This is the Village Hall Committee's Stage 1a Restoration Project starting on 12th July, as announced in March. It brings the total of awards from all external funders to £11,000. All of this money will go towards the cost of the Stage 1a project this summer.

VILLAGE HALL RESTORATION FUND TOUCHING £67,000

Just two years after the launch of Tansley Village Hall Restoration Fund, the Piggy contains almost £67,000 including pledges and awards. Included in the latest contributions is £3,702 raised through Gift Aid.

Wednesday 23rd June: England v Slovenia. 3pm.

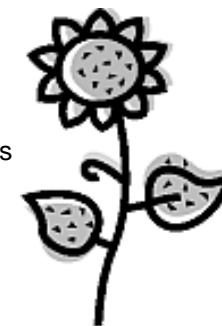
The pub will also be running sweepstakes, some of the proceeds from which will go to *Help for Heroes* and Tansley Primary School.
